Every once in a while a special dog comes into your life and Charley was that dog for me. Just a week after bringing him home, my dog Riley passed. So, Charley's first job was to heal my broken heart, and that he did.

Although I had trained my previous dogs, I had never competed with them. Charley gave me the courage and confidence to realize my dream. He was not always the easiest dog to train, but we quickly got his CGD and Therapy Dog certifications at 13 mos. We then went on to get his RN, RA, and RE. We continued with obedience and earned his CD title in one weekend. It was then back to Rally, where he earned his RAE2, becoming one of the first five AKC Cocker Spaniels to earn this title. He made me look really good as he earned all his titles – 52 times in the ring – without getting one "NQ". They were not always the best runs, he made it interesting many times, but we accomplished it just the same.

After retiring from competition due to cataracts, we concentrated more on his therapy work. He loved visiting the residents at the nursing home, and even after becoming blind, enjoyed his time with them. He made his last visit this past November with TCDTA. He was the first dog to become a Reader Dog at the Stephenson Public Library. The children just loved him; his personality made him perfect for the job.

When he lost his sight, his next job was to teach me to accept things that we cannot change. He quickly adapted to this change without missing a beat. He found ways to continue doing the things he loved... especially playing fetch!

And his final job after being diagnosed with CHF.....to remind me to live life to the fullest, to enjoy each day as it is, and to leave precious memories to those you leave behind.

Thank you, Charley, for being my "Best Boy"....see you at the Rainbow Bridge.

CLEANING AFTER CLASSES
